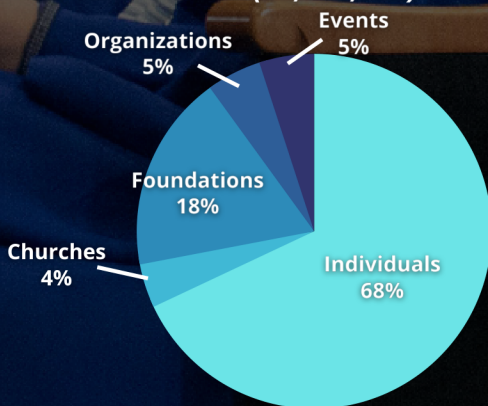

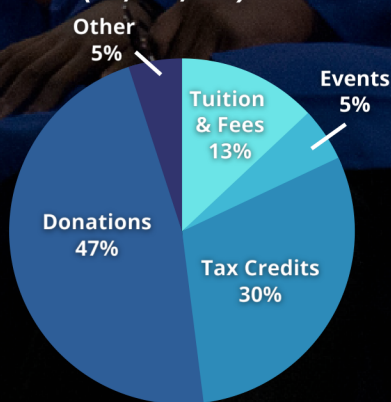
HA TOTAL DONATIONS

(\$1,409,000)



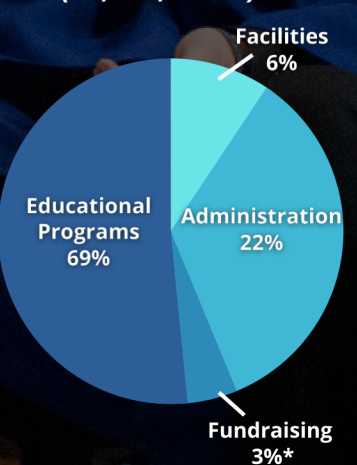
HA TOTAL INCOME

(\$2,960,000)



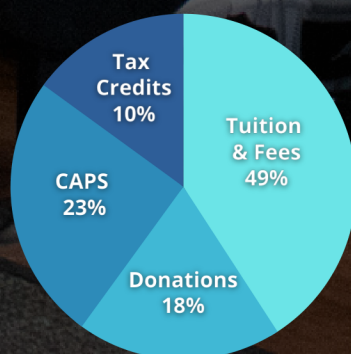
HA TOTAL EXPENSES

(\$2,215,770**)



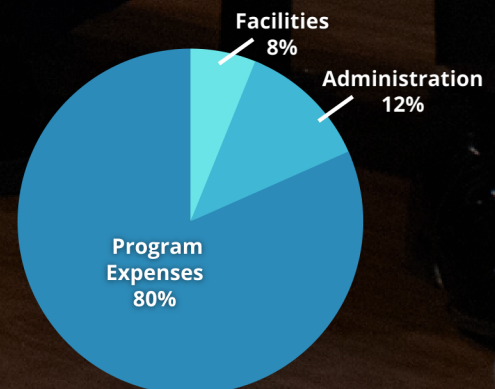
HELA TOTAL INCOME
