A Letter from our Executive Director



The 2024-2025 school year was focused on unity. Our theme of "We are One" comes from Ephesians 4:1-6. Our mission as a school community was to "(1) walk in a manner worthy of our calling... (2) bearing with one another in love". We had no way of knowing that this scripture would hold an even deeper meaning for our school community just one month after the start of school. When Hurricane Helene swept through our community, it left us all in a state of shock and a deep regard for our neighbors. Though the hurricane left a devastating impact on the landscape of our beautiful city, what it left behind was a community of strong Warriors who took care of each other, "(3) eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."

We at Heritage will forever be grateful for the outpouring of love and support for our lunch program. We knew families across the CSRA were struggling with food insecurity. With the community behind us, we fed 250 students for 11 days, breakfast and lunch. It was a blessing to many and one of my favorite moments of my tenure at Heritage to date.

(4) There is one body and one Spirit-just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call..." We challenged students to discover their calling by asking, "what comes easier to you and how can you use your gifts and talents to encourage others?" This led to service projects, students trying new things, engaging with content in a new way, and most importantly, returning thanks to the Lord by offering their talents back to Him for His glory! "(5) ...one Lord, one faith, one baptism, (6) one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all". The success of each student academically, socially, and spiritually is a direct result of the community's constant support of this beautiful mission.

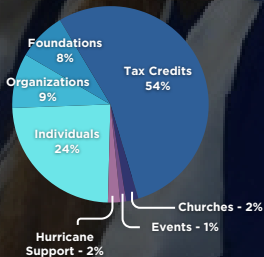
97% of Heritage Academy kindergarten students were at or above grade level in reading.

92% of Heritage Academy Grade 3 students were at or above grade level in reading.

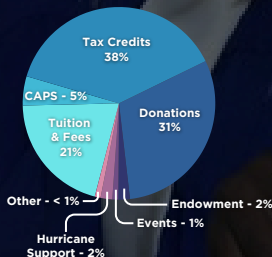
83% of Heritage Academy Grade 8 students were at or above grade level in reading.

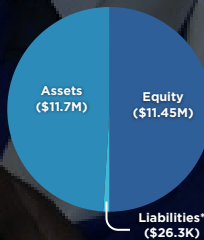
Total Donations (\$2,636,573)

Strength Through Disaster

A few days after the hurricane, I was at the grocery store (with no power) roaming the aisles with others trying to figure out what to buy that didn't need to be refrigerated or heated. Tana Watson called me to express her great concern for our students who were at home - many without power, water or access to healthy food. She knew that school was the best place for them to be and wanted to figure out a way to bring them back without any additional burden to parents. She asked, "Do you think there would be some individuals or churches who may help feed our students?" Being something we'd never tried before, we decided to express our need to the community and see what came of it. The campaign took off and within days, we had enough funding to feed our students, breakfast and lunch, for 11 days! Restaurants came forward to serve meals to our entire student body. When all was said and done, we had donors from 15 states, 49 brand new donors and gifts from current and former staff, board members, alumni of Heritage, parents and grandparents, and regular givers. Watching our community, and beyond, step forward at a hard time for all was faith-building for me. To God be the glory!
